## Paper Submission Guideline for ICTS

Authors are requested to submit an abstract or presentation proposal or full paper by email <a href="icts.sysu@gmail.com">icts.sysu@gmail.com</a>. All submissions will be forwarded to our Paper Review Panel for double-blind review. Review result will be delivered to the authors before <a href="August 31">August 31</a>, 2014 by email. Once the submission is accepted, at least one of the authors must register for and present the paper at the conference.

#### **Submission Guidelines for Abstract**

- All abstracts must be free from grammatical, spelling, and punctuation errors
- Typed, 12 pt., Times New Roman
- inch (2.54cm) for all margins and double spaced
- Page limit: 1 pages
- References in HARVARD style
- A separate cover page should include title of the paper, affiliation, author's name, contact number and email address. Please indicate the above information only on the cover page and not anywhere else
- MS Word format
- Abstract Submission Deadline: August 15, 2014

## **Submission Guidelines for Full Paper**

- All full papers must be free from grammatical, spelling, and punctuation errors.
- Typed, 12 pt., Times New Roman
- 1-inch (2.54cm) for all margins and double spaced
- Please limit your paper strictly within 12000 words
- References in HARVARD style
- A separate cover page should include title of the paper, affiliation, author's name, contact number and email address. Please indicate the above information only on the cover page and not anywhere else
- Table and Figures: Each table or figure should be presented within the text (not at the end of the text). Tables and figures should be numbered sequentially in Arabic numerals and they should bear a title (with appropriate upper and lower case letters) which explains their contents.
- MS Word format
